



TCMS Online Learning Plan

- Online Learning will consist of assignments, live videos that must be watched during their actual class time, uploaded videos, and virtual meetings. Teachers may use any technology resources available to them to instruct students- Loom, Zoom, Google Meet/Hangout, Grid-View, etc.
- Google Classroom will be utilized to communicate assignments, expectations, emails, etc. to students. Infinite Campus will be used to communicate grades on assignments to parents and students. Students are expected to log in to their Google Classroom daily, Monday through Friday, for instruction and assignments and at exact times for any live video instruction or virtual meetings.
- Grad-Point will possibly be used for 8th grade students enrolled in HS 9th grade Literature and Algebra 1, due to its use by the HS for online learning.
- Online students without WiFi will be utilizing paper/pencil assignments that must be picked up and dropped off weekly at the front desk.
- Grading will be calculated based on student work in the same manner as traditional school. Expectations for quality of work and timeliness will be enforced. Assignments not completed will negatively impact student grades.
- Students involved in extracurricular activities (clubs/sports/chorus/band, etc.) will only be allowed to participate if they are completing assignments and passing courses.
